# #1: Plot Bunnies On Demand

"Give me three romance premise ideas built around [theme or trope]. Each should include a unique emotional hook, a high-stakes complication, and a one-line summary in my tone: [smart, sensual, and emotionally grounded]."

#### Why it works:

This keeps the AI in brainstorming mode—not drafting mode. You get inspiration without outsourcing creativity.

#### **Make It Yours:**

Add your personal brand keywords ("witty banter," "slowburn sensuality," "neurospicy heroine") to guide tone. Never ask for full scenes - you don't need to because you're a storyteller, not a typist.



# #2: Character Confessional

"Interview my character, [Name]. Ask five emotionally revealing questions about their biggest fear, their secret desire, their self-sabotage, and what they'll never admit to their love interest."

#### Why it works:

Characters reveal themselves in conversation. Letting the AI interview them pulls out depth you can write into the story later - without it inventing plot.

#### Make It Yours:

Feed in your current manuscript's tone and/or comparative titles. It'll mirror your vibe better if you give it context (eg, "Think 'The Hating Game' meets Tessa Bailey").



# #3: Research Without The Doomscroll

"Summarize five quick facts about [topic] that a romance author might need for a scene, keeping it concise, contemporary, and easy to cross-check."

#### Why it works:

It saves you the time sink of doomscrolling but keeps you in control of accuracy.

#### Make It Yours:

Use this as a *starting point*, not a citation. Double-check anything factual before it hits your manuscript.





"Draft three Instagram caption outlines that promote [book or theme] in my voice: warm, confident, lightly flirtatious. Focus on emotional connection, not selling."

#### Why it works:

Al is great at tone mimicry once it knows your boundaries. This prompt keeps it human and on-brand.

#### Make It Yours:

Feed it one of your real captions as an example before asking for new ones. It'll echo your natural phrasing instead of generic fluff.



## #5: Dialogue Spark

"Give me three ways my characters could argue about [topic or scene moment], each showing different power dynamics and subtext. No full dialogue - just give me the emotional beats and one example line each."

#### Why it works:

It gives you angles, not entire scenes. You still write the words, but the emotional scaffolding appears faster.

#### Make It Yours:

Ask for specific emotional tones ("tension with humor," "quiet heartbreak," "flirty defiance") to get targeted inspiration.
